

Wagga Wagga High School BYOD Policy

BYOD Student Responsibilities

When I use my mobile digital technology:

- I will use the schools' Wi-Fi network for learning purposes only.
- I will use my device during school activities at the direction of the teacher.
- I will bring my device to school fully charged.
- I will not attach any school-owned equipment to my mobile device without the permission of the school.
- I will use my own portal/internet log-in details and will never share them with others.
- I will stay safe by not giving my personal information to strangers.
- I will not hack or bypass any hardware and software security implemented by the department or my school.
- I will not use my own device to knowingly search for, link to, access or send anything that is:
 - offensive
 - pornographic
 - threatening
 - abusive or
 - defamatory
 - considered to be bullying.
- I will report inappropriate behaviour and inappropriate material to my teacher.
- I understand that my activity on the internet is recorded and that these records may be used in investigations, court proceedings or for other legal reasons.
- I acknowledge that the school cannot be held responsible for any damage to, or theft of my device.
- I understand and have read the limitations of the manufacturer's warranty on my device, both in duration and in coverage.
- I have read the BYOD Student Responsibilities document and agree to comply with the requirements.
- I have reviewed the BYOD Device Requirements document and have ensured my device meets the minimum outlined specifications.
- I have read and will abide by the NSW Department of Education and Communities' Online Communication Services – Acceptable Usage for School Students. Which can be found at https://www.det.nsw.edu.au/policies/general_man/general/accep_use/PD20020046.shtml
- I will follow teachers' directions as to appropriate use of the devices in the classroom as use of the device during the day is at the discretion of the teachers and staff.
- Each student is absolutely and solely responsible for the care and conduct of his own personal device whilst:
 - at school or at other school activities
 - travelling to and from school or to and from other school activities
- Students must connect their device to the designated wireless data network supplied by Wagga Wagga High School using their own, individual user account credentials only. Students must not connect to any other network, wired, wireless or cellular. Students must not bridge the Wagga Wagga High School designated network to any other network.
- Students should not bring peripheral equipment, including power charges and cables to school with their device. Liability for damage or loss of peripheral equipment will in all circumstances be borne by the student.
- I will not connect my device to the schools' power supply.
- I will not connect my device to the schools' network by the use of a network cable.

Damage/loss or costs of equipment

Students bring their own device for use at Wagga Wagga High School at their own risk.

Wagga Wagga High School will not be responsible for any loss, theft or damage to:

- (a) the device
- (b) data stored on the device
- (c) any peripherals the student has brought to school

while the device is at school or during a school-related activity, absolutely, in negligence or otherwise.

In the case a student uses their own internet using their own internet provider, in contradiction to the BYOD policy, they and their parents will be responsible for any data charges incurred during this use.

Student Agreement

I have read the Acceptable Use Agreement carefully and understand the significance of the conditions and agree to abide by these conditions. I understand that any breach of these conditions will result in internet and mobile technology access privileges being suspended or revoked.
