The students were in awe of the intricate stalagmites and stalactites found in the caves at Yarrangobilly, and were able to view the management strategies in place designed to protect the fragile ecosystem. Unfortunately, due to undesirable conditions the students were unable to climb Mt Kosciuszko as planned. However, students were still able to encounter and explore the alpine region at Charlottes Pass, and conduct the necessary fieldwork. The behaviour of the students was exceptional, and we are confident the students will be able to rely upon their experiences in their HSC examination.

HELP FOR PARENTS to Keep Their Children Safe Online from The Office of the Children's Esafety Commissioner

The Commonwealth Government's Office of the Children's eSafety Commissioner has developed a resource for parents – iPARENT – which is designed to help parents learn how to be safe and secure with the connected devices in their children's lives.

iPARENT – found at https://www.esafety.gov.au/education-resources/iparent - provides facts and stats about Australian children online, managing technology in the home and strategies used by parents to keep children safe online.

A Parent's guide to online safety can be downloaded from the site and a range of useful information is available. For example, parents can access information about cyberbullying including:

- how to talk to your child;
- a parent's guide to responding to cyberbullying;
- what to do if your child is being cyberbullied or cyberbullying others; and
- sources of professional support and help.

Information is also available for parents about unwanted contact, inappropriate, offensive or illegal content and sexting.

You may like to check out the Office of the Children's e-Safety Commissioner's eSafety Christmas Gift Guide, if you are contemplating buying technology for your children this year.
