Building Positive Wellbeing

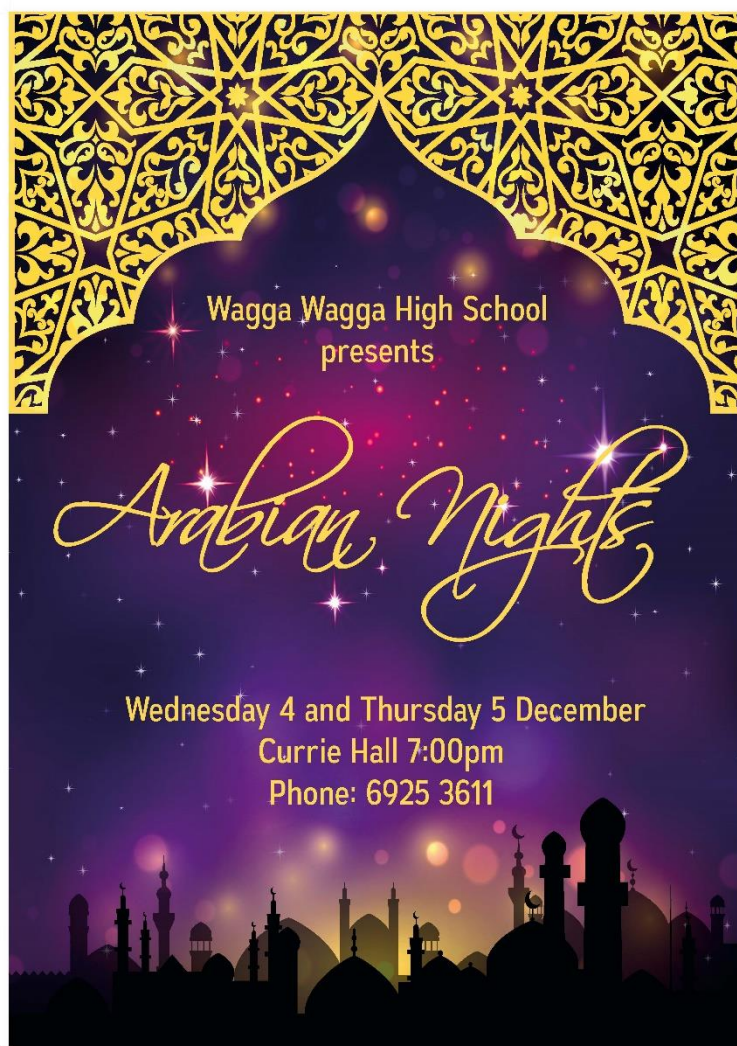
