#### Immunisations

Year 7 & 10 Immunisation cards were distributed last Thursday in roll call and must be returned to the front office by this Thursday 13 February if you wish your child to be immunised as part of the school program. If your child did not receive an envelope, they can collect one from the front office. Each year NSW Ministry of Health conducts a free school vaccination program to students throughout NSW. Teams of authorised nurses are employed to offer vaccinations to all eligible students according to National Health and Medical Research Council and Ministry of Health guidelines. In 2020 Year 7 students will be offered the two dose course of Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine as well as single doses of Boostrix vaccine and Year 10 will be offered Meningococcal ACWY vaccine. For any queries, please contact Mrs Murray or Mrs Smith.

Students are encouraged to eat breakfast and be well hydrated on the day of Immunisations. Catch up Immunisations may occur on this day for those students who were absent last year.

### Swimming Carnival 2020 & Diving

The school swimming carnival will be held on Thursday 13 February in the afternoon/evening. For those students that attend the carnival, Friday 14 February will be a rest day. Students are allowed to wear sports colours to school during the day, the more flamboyant outfits should wait until just before carnival time. #### **RMS Safer Drivers Course**

NDE Australia are currently conducting the Roads & Maritime Service (RMS) Safer Driver Course in Wagga Wagga, for Learner Drivers. The next course will be held at the Wagga Wagga RSL, Dodds Street Wagga Wagga, on Sunday 9 February 2020, commencing at 9:00am. The course consists of a 3 hour theory session followed by a 2 hour practical driving session, which involves low risk driving techniques. The 2 hour session entails 2 students, completing 1 hour drive each, on a pre prepared route. The course provides 20 hours of log time in the Learner Drivers Handbook for \$140. Drivers need to have 50 log book hours to qualify for the course. This is great value for students and families and can be completed in 1 day. Lunch is provided at the training venue. The Facilitators and coaches are highly skilled and experienced and provide easy to understand instruction, which will assist young drivers to gain valuable experience and safe driving techniques.

Schools, sporting clubs, youth groups, and other organisations involved in supporting young people up to the age of 25 years, can now apply for a Murrumbidgee Youth Community Grant to receive funding for activities aimed at building resilience and positive mental health and wellbeing.

The initiative is part of Murrumbidgee Primary Health Network's (MPHN), Federal Government Empowering Our Communities funding to support mental health and wellbeing in the region's drought affected communities.

The Murrumbidgee Youth Community Grants have two funding levels, up to \$1,500 where a simple 250-word overview of the activity and a basic budget is required to apply. The next level is for grants of more than \$1,500 and up to \$5,000, which will require a 500 word overview and a more detailed budget and quotes. Application to approval of funding should take no more than two weeks.

Grant applications close on Friday, 27 March 2020 or when funding is exhausted. All grant activities must be complete by 30 June 2020.
