### Textiles Colouration Workshops

Year 9 Textile students were given the opportunity to attend a colouration workshop to develop and build upon their colouration skills. Many different techniques were demonstrated, which the students were able to then apply to various textile bases of their own. These skills and techniques included tie dyeing, screen printing, stencilling combining with playcolours, Inkense pencils and shiva oil paintstiks, printing with Transfer Artist Paper (TAP) using an inkjet printer, angelina fibres, glitter sheets, needle felting and distorting of Tyvek. Each student had a valuable, educational experience and thoroughly enjoyed their day. They will now be able to apply their new knowledge and skills during technology and textiles lessons.
