### Twilight Swimming Carnival

Our twilight swimming carnival will be held next Thursday 11 February. - Students come to school as per normal for the first 5 periods, they will get changed at lunch time into sports house colours, a short assembly will be held before walking to the pool. Students must wear enclosed shoes for the walk down, thongs can be worn once you are at the pool.
- The carnival will commence at 3pm and will be finished by 8pm, it has been earlier in years past.
- The staff at Oasis has specified no hair dye, no zinc, no coloured crepe paper streamers and no horns to be at the premises.
- Kiosk facilities will be available but only at specific time allocations, so children should bring snacks & drinks also.
- Unfortunately no spectators are permitted at the carnival.
- Please note our school canteen will not be operating Friday 12.
- A permission note will be sent home requesting the \$4 pool entry fee be paid at the school office prior to the carnival.
