

Term 3 Staff Development Day Change of Date

Staff professional development is essential to provide the best education and support for your children. Access to these quality facilitators is at times a challenge with many dates such as Staff Development Days becoming difficult to book. The three public high schools (Wagga Wagga High School, Kooringal High School and Mt Austin High School) are combining for a day of training and we have been able to book a wellbeing expert who will lead the professional learning. This will mean that we need to change the date of our normal Staff Development Day from Monday 18 th July to Friday 22nd of July This will mean that Monday 18 th July, will now be a normal school day and all students are expected to attend. Friday July 22 will now be a Staff Development Day and normal classes will not be run on this day (Pupil Free Day). As we know this may cause issues for families and childcare, all three schools will be offering minimal supervision to parents who have no other options but to send their children to school to allow the staff to access this important training but support families as required.

Industrial Action

The NSW Teachers Federation has directed its members to take industrial action in the form of a 24-hour strike this Thursday June 30, 2022. As a result, our school will be providing minimal student supervision on this date. These changes are required to meet safety and supervision requirements. Students arriving at school at the regular time will assemble in the quad and wait for direction from the teachers onsite. The canteen will not be open on this day and the students will need to bring their recess and lunch with them to school.
